Howard Kunreuther, Cecilia Yen Koo Professor, Professor of Decision Sciences and Public Policy and Management, Co-Director, Risk Management and Decision Processes Center, The Wharton School of The University of Pennsylvania

Professor Kunreuther has a long-standing interest in ways that society can better manage low-probability/high-consequence events related to technological and natural hazards, and has published extensively on the topic. He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) and a Distinguished Fellow of the Society for Risk Analysis, receiving the Society's Distinguished Achievement Award in 2001. Dr. Kunreuther recently served as a member of the National Academy of Sciences *Panel on Adaptation Strategies for Climate Change*, and co-chaired the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on *Innovation and Leadership in Reducing Risks from Natural Disasters*. He currently serves on the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on *Humanitarian Assistance 2010*, and the OECD's High Level Advisory Board on Financial Management of Large-Scale Catastrophes. His most recent books are *At War with the Weather* (with Erwann Michel-Kerjan) (July 2009, MIT Press), and *Learning from Catastrophes: Strategies for Reaction and Response* (with Michael Useem) (January 2010, Wharton School Publishing).
