Robert Shiller has written on financial markets, financial innovation, behavioral economics, macroeconomics, real estate, statistical methods, and on public attitudes, opinions, and moral judgments regarding markets. His book *Irrational Exuberance* is an analysis and explication of speculative bubbles, with special reference to the stock market and real estate. His book [*Subprime Solution: How the Global Financial Crisis Happened and What to Do about It*](#), published in September 2008 by Princeton University Press, offers an analysis of the housing and economic crisis and a plan of action against it. He co-authored, with George A. Akerlof, [*Animal Spirits: How Human Psychology Drives the Economy and Why It Matters for Global Capitalism*](#) published in March 2009 by Princeton University Press.
