In 1994, Chris was among one of the first Big Four consultants to relocate to China where he assisted various multinational companies in developing their China investment strategies. In 1997, Chris relocated to Chicago, where he led the M&A services to Ford Motor Company in Asia Pacific. In this role, Chris led many large due diligence projects in Asia. Afterwards, Chris returned to Beijing to focus on PE and U.S. inbound investment. In 2010, Chris repatriated back to San Jose, California to lead Deloitte's China Services in the United States.

Chris serves on the board of directors for The 100K Strong Foundation, an organization focusing on promoting the expansion and diversification of Americans learning Mandarin and studying abroad in China. Furthermore, Chris is also a board member of the International School of the Peninsula and the Golden Bridges Foundation.

In 1988, Chris graduated from the Ross School of Business at the University of Michigan. Chris is a qualified member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accounts and he holds a CPA license in both Michigan and California.
