
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Monthly ILC reports will be discontinued; related data available via other programs

Beginning October 1, The Conference Board will no longer issue monthly ILC reports on consumer prices and employment. This step will allow The Conference Board to dedicate more resources to continuing and strengthening of the annual ILC reports on labor compensation, productivity and competitiveness. The underlying data tables on monthly consumer prices and employment will continue to be published on The Conference Board website through December 2014. Beginning January 1, 2015, related data series will be available via the Business Cycle Indicators program on a subscription basis. Historical monthly and annual datasets will remain publicly available on The Conference Board website.

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




CHART 3. Unemployment rates adjusted to US concepts, seasonally adjusted July 2013 - July 2014


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
