His work has appeared in such journals as *Communications in Statistics*, *Stochastic Models*, *Mathematical Finance*, and *The Journal of Finance*. After obtaining his Ph.D., Subramanian spent four years in industry as a quantitative research associate with the investment firm Susquehanna International Group in Bala Cynwyd, Pennsylvania.
