His teams deliver capabilities that combine robust data, traditional machine learning AI, generative AI, and agentic AI technologies—focused on building human-centric solutions that improve the daily experience of both employees and customers.

Known for marrying business strategy with cutting-edge innovation, Justin has consistently helped Southwest turn digital transformation into a competitive advantage. His 17+ year journey at Southwest spans a wide range of enterprise initiatives, including financial planning, enterprise performance management, business analytics, and strategic data programs.
