Hillard G. Huntington is the Executive Director of the Energy Modeling Forum at Stanford University, where he conducts studies to improve the use of modeling and analysis for understanding energy and environmental markets. His research publications span a range of interests, including oil markets and security and the impacts of price shocks, restructured electricity and natural gas markets, the control of greenhouse gases and other emissions, and energy demand and efficiency.

Prior to coming to Stanford in 1980, he held positions at Data Resources (now, Global Insight) and the U.S. Federal Energy Administration. He is a Senior Fellow and past President of the United States Association for Energy Economics, past Vice President for Publications for the International Association for Energy Economics, and a Life Member of Clare Hall at the University of Cambridge (United Kingdom). Dr. Huntington is a member of the National Petroleum Council and has served on various national and international panels, including a joint US Russian National Academy of Sciences Panel on Energy Conservation Research and Development and the American Statistical Association's Committee on Energy Statistics.

He received a B.S. from Cornell University and a Ph.D. in economics from the State University of New York at Binghamton.
