In 2003 and 2012, he was Visiting Professor and Fellow at the Saïd Business School, University of Oxford, in 2008 Max Schmidheiny Visiting Professor for Entrepreneurship and Risk at the University of St. Gallen, in 2011 Visiting Professor at Stanford Law School and in 2013 a Visiting Senior Fellow at Columbia Law School.

Becht is a Founder Member, a Fellow and the Executive Director of the European Corporate Governance Institute ([www.ecgi.org](http://www.ecgi.org)), an international non-profit scientific association.

Beyond his core academic activities Becht is a member of the Kangaroo Group at the European Parliament, the Group of Financial Market Law Experts at the German Ministry of Finance and a Senior Adviser to Oxera, the Economic Consultancy
