Mr. Brennan joined Vanguard in July 1982. Headquartered in Malvern, Pennsylvania, Vanguard comprises more than 170 separate domestic investment portfolios, with current U.S. fund assets of more than \$1.8 trillion. He was elected president in 1989, served as chief executive officer from 1996 to 2008, and chairman of the board from 1998 to 2009.

Mr. Brennan is a director of General Electric Company; a director of LPL Financial; a director of Guardian Life Insurance Company of America; a governor and lead governor of the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA); and sits on several other non-profit and academic boards.

Mr. Brennan graduated from Dartmouth College and earned a master's degree in business administration from the Harvard Business School. He has received honorary degrees from Curry College and Drexel University.
