Shawn Zimmerman is Vice President, Global Talent & Organization Capability, for The Hershey Company. In this role, Zimmerman leads Hershey's Talent Planning, Talent Acquisition, Diversity, Inclusion and Engagement, Learning and Organizational Development and Performance Management. He is responsible for the creation of an integrated *Win With Talent – Plan Attract Grow* talent strategy that differentiates Hershey from its competitors through strategic talent planning, attracting, retaining and developing the talent necessary for future global growth. He and his team develop enterprise wide talent management programming designed to enable execution of the company strategy. During his time at Bristol-Myers Squibb, Zimmerman led the organizational redesign and change management of the Intercontinental Region, partnered in the creation of a new enterprise-wide BioPharma Talent Strategy, and was the Americas regional HR lead in the split-off of the Mead Johnson Nutritionals business. Prior to that, Zimmerman held roles of increasing leadership and responsibility at James River, AlliedSignal and Citibank.
