His current fields of specialization include human capital and earnings inequality, labor market impacts of technological change and globalization, disability insurance and labor supply, and temporary help and other intermediated work arrangements. Dr. Autor received a BA in psychology from Tufts University and a PhD in public policy at Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government.
